**All roads are open to traffic at all times during the tour.** NZ Road rules must be obeyed at all times. **Do not cross the centre line.** Marshals will be sited at all intersections/turns to assist you, please accept their directions. During all stages other than stage 3, support will be provided by wheel vans following each grade. Outside assistance by supporters including feeding is not permitted. Motor pacing is not permitted.

**Supporters vehicles** are not permitted to follow or become involved in the race. Observe only from a safe location along the route or at stage finishes.

**Wheel Vans** for each grade are the responsibility of the Grade Rep. Drivers are to report to the Tour Director/STMS each day for briefing. Wheels are to be clearly marked with your race number. It is the rider's responsibility to collect wheels after each stage.

**Race Numbers** must be pinned centrally over the jersey pockets.

**Timing transponders** must be fitted for all stages. Mount the holder on the front left fork one hand width below the wheel rim. Return transponders on completion of the tour. There will be a \$50 surcharge for lost transponders.

**E/F Grades** No entries

**Women A Grade** Insufficient entries. Will run as part of C Grade but retain GC jersey only.

**Women B Grade** will be combined with either Men's D Grade retaining its own GC/QOM/Points jerseys

**Sprint Ace** 3,2,1 points awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> three placings at each point.

**KOM/QOM** 3,2,1 points awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> three placings at each point

**Time Bonuses** 10sec, 7sec, 4sec deducted from GC time for 1<sup>st</sup> three placings at each stage (F grades only, time bonuses applied to both 1<sup>st</sup> three men and 1<sup>st</sup> three women)

**Jerseys** will be awarded to the leaders on GC, Sprint Ace Points and KOM Points for each grade at the start of each stage. Jerseys are to be returned to the race manager immediately after each stage finish.

**Ties** will be resolved on GC by faster time in Stage 2 (Time Trial), UCI Rule 2.6.015. Sprint and KOM ties will be resolved in accordance with UCI Rule 2.6.017

**Protests** must be submitted in a professional manner to the Chief Commissaire within 30 minutes of a stage finish. The decision of the Commissaires panel will be final.

**Parking** on Sunday at Tai Tapu. Do not park on Tai Tapu Road between Michaels Road and the Tai Tapu Country Club. Use side roads in the vicinity of the Tai Tapu Hall only.

**Rubbish** Please take all your rubbish home with you.

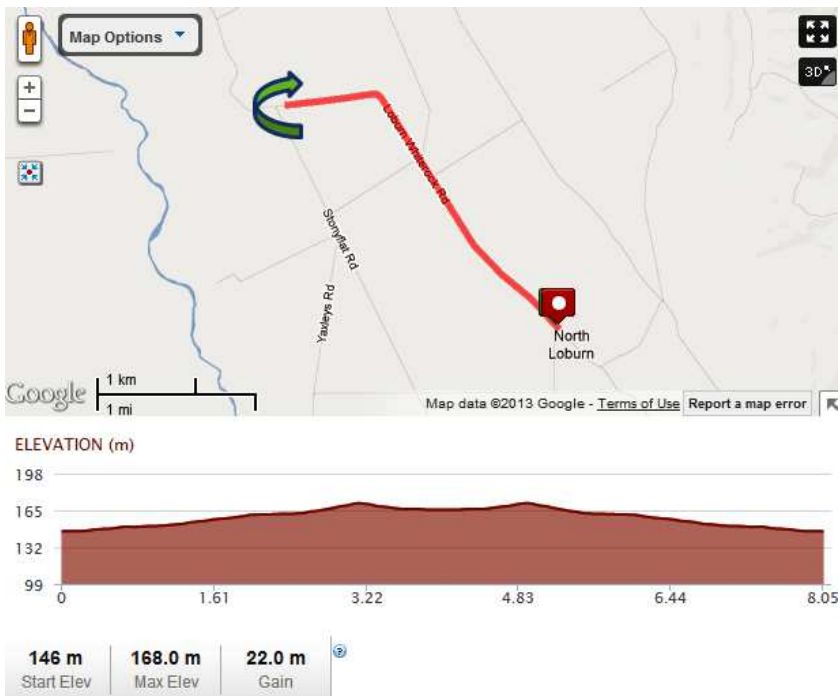

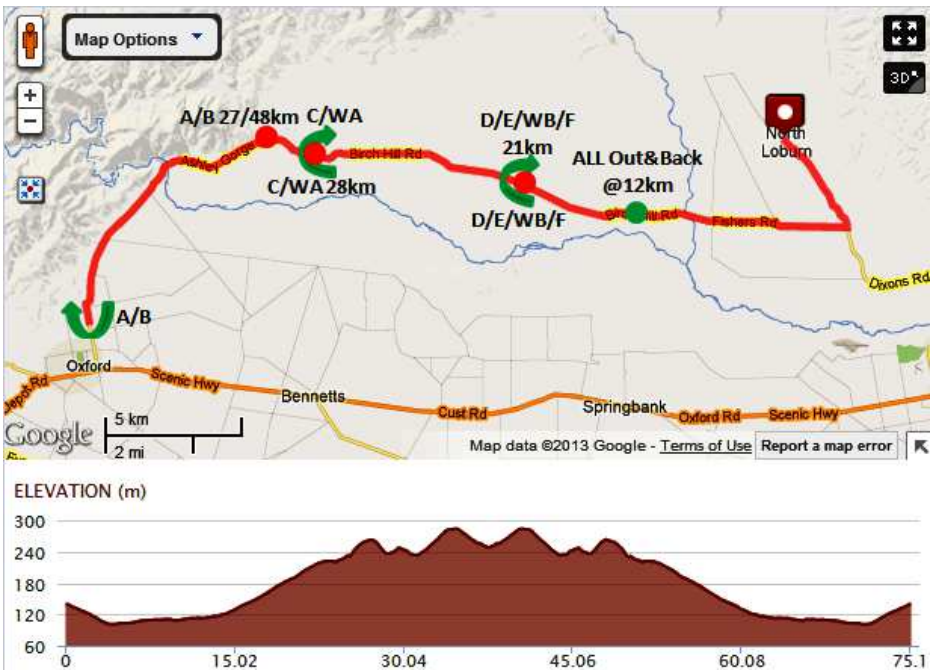

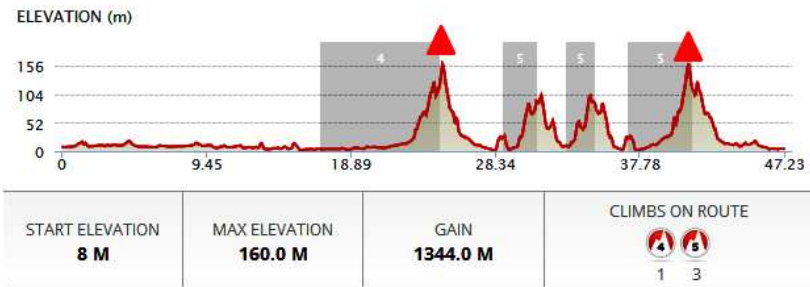
