### **CLUB MANAGEMENT AND VOLUNTEERS**

We hope you are all enjoying the winter break and looking forward to our new season of racing kicking off in mid-August. The programme is already up on the club website and on the club Facebook Events pages with a mix of races to suit all abilities and preferences.

As you are fully aware, these events cannot take place safely without the input of club members acting as volunteers (primarily as race marshals). The system already in place calling for volunteers as part of the on line registration system will continue and we cannot impress enough the need to check your diaries and schedules and put your names in to volunteer whenever possible. The number of marshals required for each race is on the calendar and each week is also included in the on line race details.

Additionally we will be losing one of our valued Event Officials with Andrew Jones moving back home to Australia shortly which leaves us very thin on the ground with people qualified in Traffic Management. We urgently need volunteers to be trained up initially as Traffic Controllers (TC) which consists of a 1 day course (funded by the club). This will enable you to set up and remove course traffic management equipment under the supervision of a Site Traffic Management supervisor (STMS). It would be hoped that once qualified as a TC some would wish also to upgrade to become an STMS. These are vital roles in club events on public roads, without whom no events can legally be run. Finally, our AGM is coming up, scheduled for Monday 11 September 2017. Over the past 12 months we have lost a few Board Members and in particular we are seeking new blood to fill the roles of Handicapper (to maintain the handicap ladder and oversee handicaps/gradings for events) and a Junior Development Manager (to manage and oversee the Junior Race Programme).
